Conference faculty will offer critiques of up to 10 pages of your manuscript, in addition to a *one-page* optional synopsis or query letter, submitted no later than **July 10, 2015**. Your assigned faculty member will review the manuscript excerpt prior to their arrival, then meet privately with you in a one-on-one setting during the conference to discuss and analyze your work for fifteen minutes.

Cost: \$45.00 per submission for AWG or SCBWI Members

\$60.00 per submission for non-members

Up to three (3) manuscript excerpts per attendee will be accepted

Guidelines:

Ш	All manuscript excerpts and query letters/synopses should be typed in 12 point 11mes New
	Roman font with 1-inch margins.
	Submit no more than 10 pages of your manuscript, double-spaced
	In addition to your manuscript excerpt, you have the option to include a one-page,
	single-spaced synopsis or query letter.
	Include your name and page numbers on all pages of your manuscript, with your full contact
	information on the title page.
	Send all material for each manuscript review submission as a single .doc or .docx document
	(for example, if you are sending a query letter along with your manuscript excerpt, both
	need to be in the same document).

Please note that *no text from the body of your email* will be sent to the critiquing faculty, only your document. Send all submissions as an email attachment to **bahartman@me.com** no later than **July 10, 2015**. Any submissions received after July 10 will not be sent to faculty for critique, and your fee(s) will not be refunded.

- In the subject line of your email, type "Conference Manuscript Review"
- In the body of the e-mail, clearly type your full name as you used for your conference registration.
- Indicate the type of writing and age group, such as nonfiction short story, young adult science fiction novel, picture book, etc.
- Make note of your first and second choice of faculty reviewer. We cannot guarantee faculty critique assignments.
